

DNR ACCOUNTABILITY FOR PROPER WASTE MANAGEMENT

Penalties for Improper Mining

Currently, Missouri has insufficient penalties for failure to meet certain mining procedures. The legislature must increase the penalty for mining without a permit and mining in cities or towns with a population of over 1000 citizens.





Greater Government Oversight

In areas across the state, Missourians are being impacted by abandoned mines that have been neglected. Our government must ensure that these mines are cleaned-up properly and that government entities are overseeing the mine-retirement process.

Minimum Design Standards

Loopholes in the current regulations surrounding multiindustry waste producers, such as Denali Water Solutions, have allowed for these facilities to avoid accountability for their impacts on local communities. The Legislature must remove this loophole in order to hold these facilities to the safety standards that have been put in place to protect Missourians.



The government must take further action to ensure these facilities are implementing necessary safeguards that prevent any substandard actions on behalf of the facilities.
